Classical Civilisation: The Epics of Homer - UEA & Edinburgh - June 10

We are really pleased to welcome speakers from The University of Edinburgh and University of East Anglia on 10th June to explore The Epics of Homer.

With each speaker presenting an interactive micro talk, Dr Jo Poppleton from UEA will begin by examining hospitality/xenia in The Odyssey. Jo will analyse the rituals through which the bonds of guest-friendship are formed and ask how these rituals might work to temper the potential threat of strangers and diminish the likelihood of violence and aggression.

Then Dr Calum Maciver from Edinburgh will look at *Alternative 'Achilles Stories'* in Homer's Iliad introducing the idea of 'neoanalysis' and discussing its usefulness as a tool to interpret the characterisation of Achilles in Homer's Iliad.
