Paper to be sat:	The Making of a Superpower, USA 1865-1975 & The Making of Modern Britain, 1951-2007.
Topics to be covered in the exam:	For the American paper the students need to revise the period 1865-1920 – for the period 1890-1920 the exam will only cover the political and economic content. For the British paper students need to revise the period 1951-1964 and Wilson 1964-70 social policy.
